Some highlights from the Fall AGM:

- All sections of the wood ramp will be removed by the 2017 season, making the docks safer to use. VC Fleet Bill Downes discussed the task of weekly pushing the docks out into the water and mentioned that it will become the responsibility of the racing PRO to have the docks pushed out.
- Extending the concrete ramp was raised and Maintenance Captain Paul Coppes advised that the GRCA says it cannot be extended due to protecting the fish habitat of the lake.
- Chris Zimmerman made a motion to purchase an additional 10 foot section of the EZ dock. Andy Blackmore seconded the motion. All in favour. Motion carried. Dock section to be installed in the spring
- The 2017 Pro Tem budget with amended wording regarding potential purchase of the motor boat from the Mirror Association was moved by Frank Laszlo and seconded by Al Hilborn. All in favour, motion carried.
- Ed Davis thanked the race committee for their contribution during the race season. Richard King reported the Y-Flyer International was a fantastic event. The conditions were perfect (the wind didn't fade away in the afternoon heat) over the four day event


